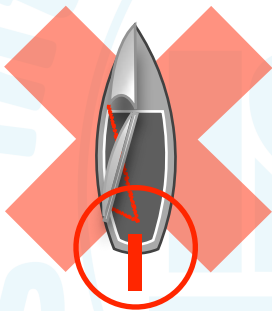


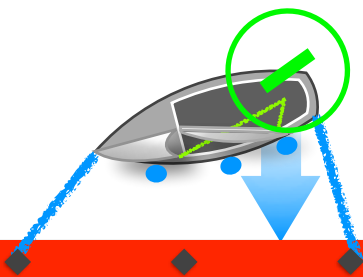
# WHY?

In ancient times  
central rudder was too difficult to mount



So it was mounted on the right side

Why on the right?  
Most of us is  
right handed



Such boats would always  
moor with their left side  
to a peer, in order  
not to damage the rudder

Left - STOP - Port  
RED

# SO

Right - GO - Steer  
GREEN
